



Last month, the FAA gave businesses and industries across the country the legal ability to integrate an Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) into their operations. Over **500,000 UAS are registered with the FAA**, and more registrations are processed each day.

The new rules regulate operations and safety for [drones weighing less than 55 pounds](#). The UAS rules are designed to minimize risks to other aircraft, and people and property on the ground.
